Notes to accompany Student Application for Financial Assistance

- 1. Medleys Charity exists to help people who are poor and live in Tydd St Mary.
- 2. The Charity Trustees give financial help to young people and their parents to cover the expenses of those who have left school and are taking on further education, whether that is a degree or apprenticeship. The Trustees will also consider applications from parents who need assistance with school uniforms at secondary school.
- 3. The Trustees do not disclose any financial details given by the Applicants or their parents to anybody else. When the applications have been dealt with and grants paid, any financial details are destroyed and not retained.
- 4. A lot of further education courses last for more than one year. Applicants will need to reapply to the Trustees each year and will need to attach to their application a letter or other proof from their tutor/supervisor/employer confirming that the Applicant has attended the course and performed satisfactorily.
- 5. Please do not hold back making your application until you know your results. The Trustees will make the decision on each application and, if need be, delay payment until the results are known.
- 6. Please be aware that the Trustees' decisions are final and cannot be challenged, nor will they enter into correspondence concerning their decisions.
